Alice Kayitare is a Rwandan successful entrepreneur who has employed thirty people in her expanding Agaseke Rukundo Enterprise (ARE). ARE has been making a variety of handcrafts for domestic and export market for the last seven years. Most of ARE's raw materials are reeds and rare shrubs from swamplands and forest areas in Rwanda. Over-harvesting has made ARE workers to travel to areas bordering Congo and Uganda in search of good quality materials. Although production has been growing in leaps and bounds, demand for her products far outstrips supply. ARE's expenses are increasing rapidly and can hardly meet the cost of overheads. Consequently, ARE's profits have been reducing in the last three years. Most of ARE marketing is by word of mouth and ocassional exhibitions at national and international market hubs. To rejuvenate her business, Kayitare often makes frequent and sometimes prolonged travels outside Rwanda to East Africa and USA on marketing missions. Her family has expressed concern over these travels that have considerably reduced her time with family.
